1. Product profile

1.1 General description

Planar passivated high commutation three quadrant triac in a SOT78D (TO-220AB) internally insulated plastic package intended for use in circuits where high static and dynamic dV/dt and high dl/dt can occur. This "series C" triac will commutate the full RMS current at the maximum rated junction temperature without the aid of a snubber. This device has an internally isolated mounting base.

1.2 Features and benefits

- 3Q technology for improved noise immunity
- High commutation capability with maximum false trigger immunity
- High immunity to false turn-on by dV/dt
- Isolated mounting base with 2500 V (RMS) isolation
- Less sensitive gate for high noise immunity




Fig. 1. RMS on-state current as a function of surge duration; maximum values




Fig. 2. RMS on-state current as a function of mounting base temperature; maximum values




Fig. 3. Total power dissipation as a function of RMS on-state current; maximum values

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


Fig. 4. Non-repetitive peak on-state current as a function of pulse duration; maximum values




Fig. 5. Non-repetitive peak on-state current as a function of the number of sinusoidal current cycles; maximum values






Fig. 7. Normalized gate trigger current as a function of junction temperature




Fig. 8. Normalized latching current as a function of junction temperature

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



Fig. 9. Normalized holding current as a function of junction temperature

Fig. 10. On-state current as a function of on-state voltage




Fig. 11. Normalized gate trigger voltage as a function of junction temperature




Fig. 12. Package outline TO-220AB (SOT78D)
