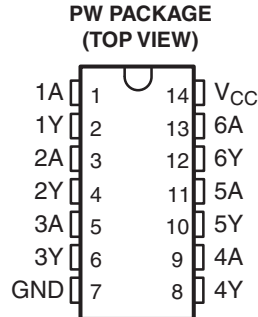


## HEX SCHMITT-TRIGGER INVERTER

### DESCRIPTION

This Schmitt-trigger device contains six independent inverters. They perform the Boolean function  $Y = A$ . Because of the Schmitt action, they have different input threshold levels for positive-going ( $V_{T+}$ ) and for negative-going ( $V_{T-}$ ) signals.

These circuits are temperature compensated and can be triggered from the slowest of input ramps and still give clean, jitter-free output signals. They also have a greater noise margin than conventional inverters.

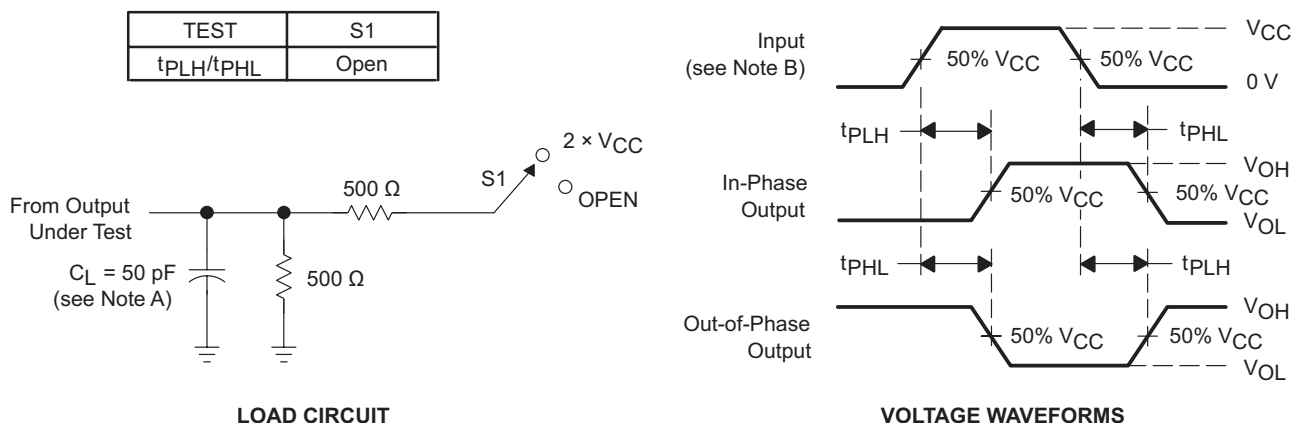

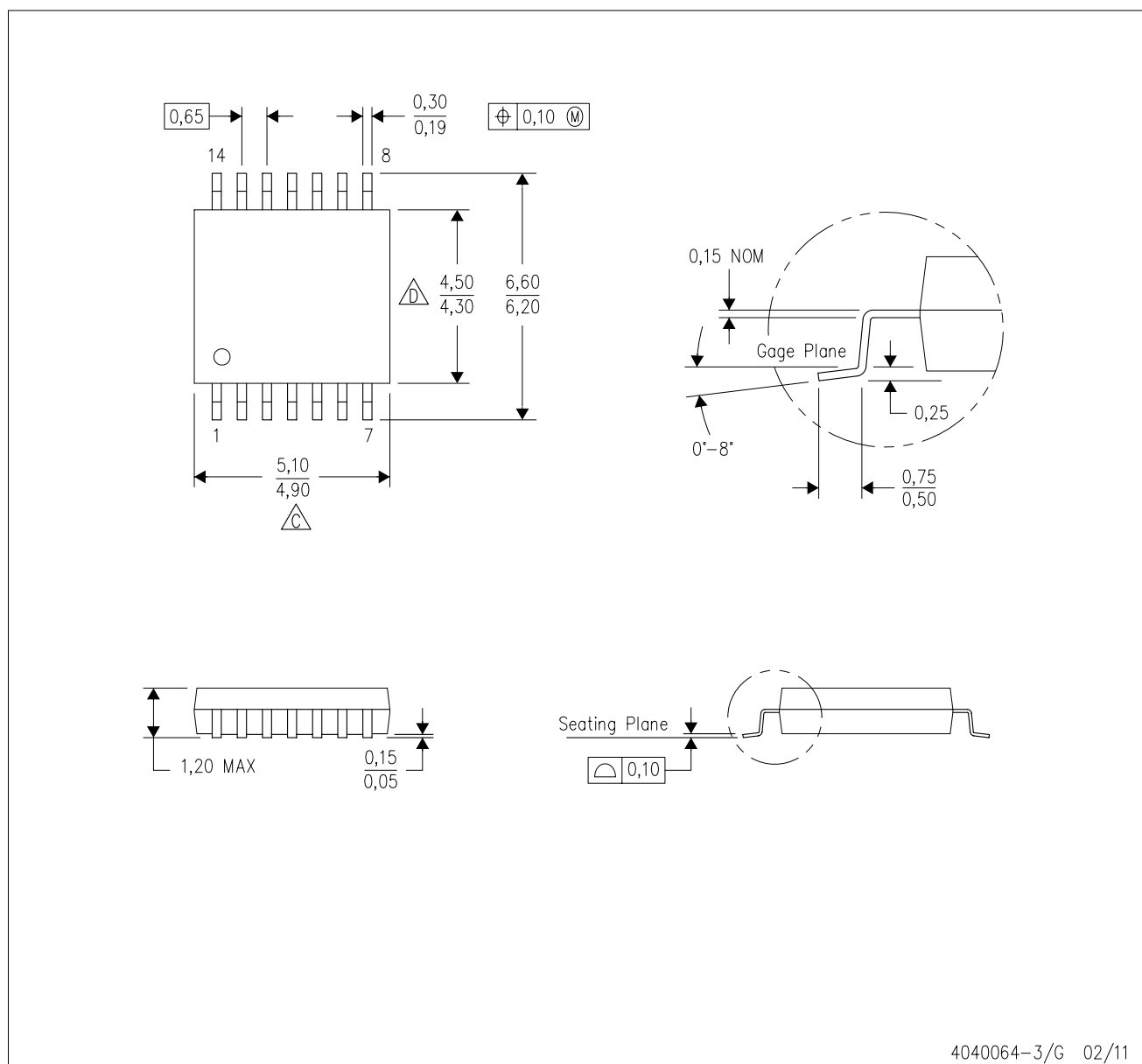

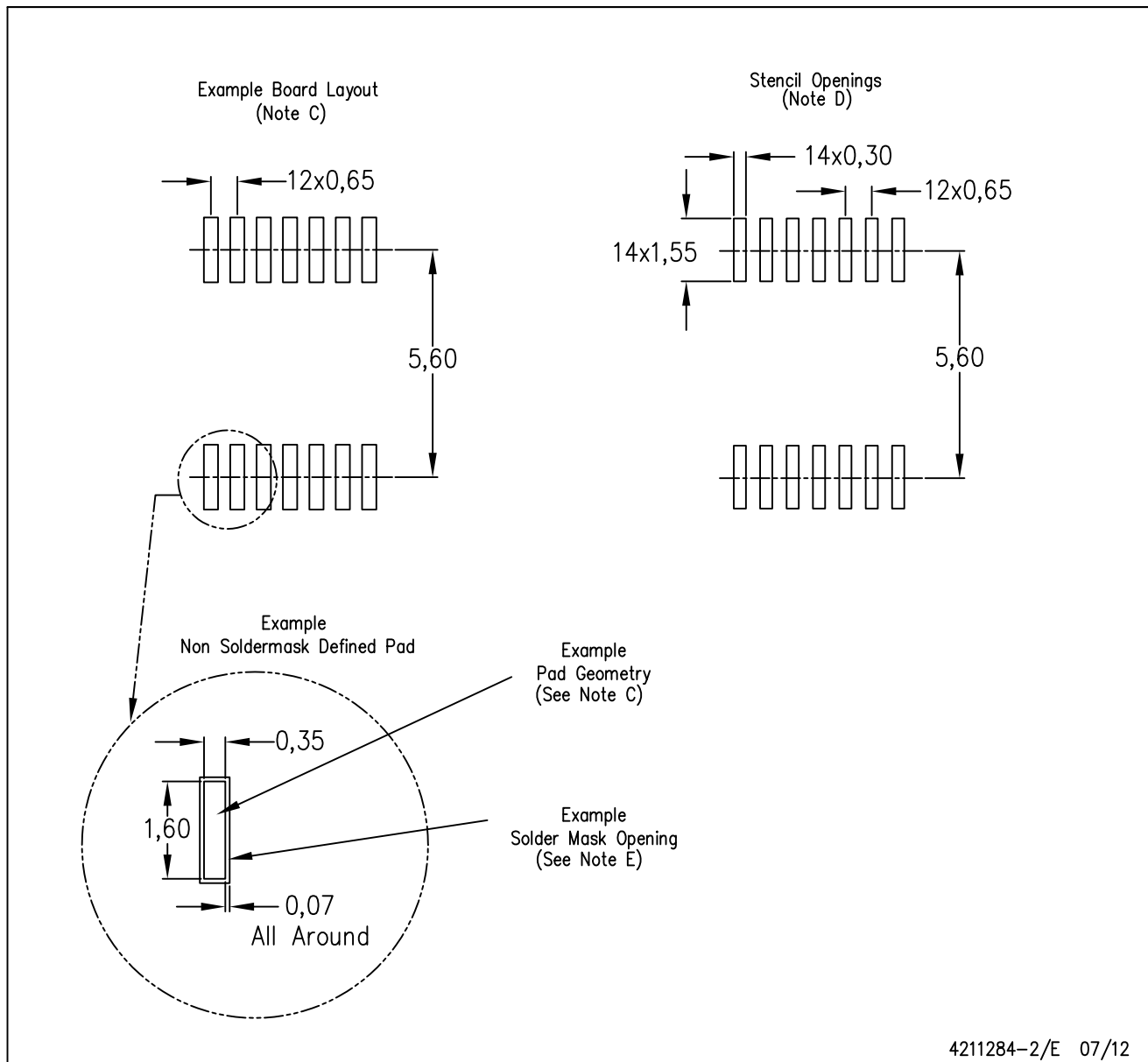
